



Subject: Housekeeping Amendment to By-law 150-2012

Report to: Thorold City Council

Recommendation

1. That report DS 023-2023 **BE RECEIVED**; and
2. That necessary by-law **BE PREPARED** and **PRESENTED** to Council for approval.

Key Facts

- On January 17, 2023, Council approved amendments to the Parking & Traffic By-law adopting prohibitions to on-street parking during a declared parking ban.
- A typo has been discovered in the amending by-law.
- By-law 61-2023 amends By-law 150-2012 to correct the previous typographical error

Budgetary Status

There are not any budgetary implications associated with this report or By-law 61-2023.

Analysis

On January 17, 2023, Council approved By-law 10-2023 which made amendments to Parking & Traffic By-law No.150-2012.

By-law 10-2023 states;

That Section 3.9.1. of By-law No. 150-2012 be amended to add clause (12) as follows:

(12) for a period of time in which the City of Thorold has declared an on-street parking ban in accordance with Section 4.8.

It has since been identified that clause 3.9.1. (12) already existed within By-law No. 150-2012 and therefore By-law 10-2023 has added a second clause (12) to Section

3.9.1. of the By-law. The duplication of clause numbers can lead to confusion and errors with the implementation and enforcement of the by-law.

By-law 61-2023 removes the administrative error and renumbers the second clause (12) in Section 3.9.1. to clause (13).
