To Mayor and Council:

The Thorold BIA would like to host the Thorold BIA Friday Cruise Nights on Front Street every Friday evening, May 5th to September 15th/2023. We would like to close Front Street from Clairmont Street to Regent Street to make room for all the cars and spectators, while leaving a central lane for emergency vehicles. Times for closure would be 5PM till dusk.

In regards to Part C of the Special Event Planning Form, washrooms would be available at local open businesses. Cleanup will be handled by the BIA and our volunteers before leaving the site and music may be played through our downtown speakers.

There will be no alcohol and no food served. Insurance for this event will be through the City of Thorold as it's a BIA event and taking place on the street.

The BIA will position the barricades themselves placing 2 on Front @ Sullivan, 2 on Front St. @ Clairmont, 2 on Front St. @ Regent, 1 on Front St. @ MacArthur Lane, 1 on Front St. @ Albert on the West side and 1 on Albert East of Front St. (by the old license bureau).

The BIA will contact the bus lines about the road closure. The BIA will also put up "No Parking" signs (supplied by Public Works) Friday afternoon within the road closure to limit cars in the event area. All businesses within the road closure will be notified in advance of the road closing.

The BIA requests a parking ban be put in effect between the hours of 5 PM and dusk every Friday evening for the requested dates.

Due to the event being open to everyone in the community and surrounding area and drawing attention and bodies into the heart of the City of Thorold, the BIA requests that the City waive all fees associated with this event.

As people are beginning to get out more, we look forward to drawing them to downtown Thorold for this fun, family friendly, outdoor event.
