BY-LAW NO. 68-2023

A BY-LAW TO DESIGNATE LOCK 25, BATTLE OF  
BEAVERDAMS PARK UNDER PART IV OF THE ONTARIO  
HERITAGE ACT

---

WHEREAS Section 29 of the *Ontario Heritage Act*, R.S.O. 1990, as amended, authorizes the Council of a municipality to designate property within the municipality to be of cultural heritage value or interest; and

WHEREAS the Municipal Heritage Advisory Committee is recommending the designation of Lock 25 (Second Welland Canal) under Part IV of the *Ontario Heritage Act*; and

WHEREAS Council approved proceeding with the Notice of Intention to Designate the property at the Special Council Meeting held April 28<sup>th</sup>, 2023; and

WHEREAS the Clerk proceeded with the proper notification requirements listed in the *Ontario Heritage Act*; and

WHEREAS no objections were received to the proposed designation of Lock 25 under Part IV of the *Ontario Heritage Act*.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Thorold enacts as follows:

1. That the property described in Schedule “A” attached hereto is hereby designated under Part IV of the *Ontario Heritage Act* to be of historic, architectural and contextual value. The Statement of Cultural Heritage Value of Interest is set out in Schedule “B” attached hereto.
2. This By-law shall come into effect on the final passing thereof by the Council of the Corporation of the City of Thorold.
3. That the Clerk be authorized to proceed with the final notification and steps prescribed under the *Ontario Heritage Act* to complete the designation process.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed by Council this **30<sup>th</sup>** day of **May**, 2023.
