WHEREAS Sarah King Head CAHP, has conducted research (appended to this motion) on the potential for a Cultural Heritage Designation of Lock 25 of the Second Welland Canal, located at The Battle of Beaverdams Park;

WHEREAS the Heritage Advisory Committee is recommending this designation; and

WHEREAS designation of this structure will support the City of Thorold's cultural heritage goal and objective to identify, conserve, and enhance its significant cultural heritage resources.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Corporation of the City of Thorold enact as follows:

- 1. That Thorold City Council **CONSIDER** Lock 25, located at the Battle of Beaverdams Park, in the City of Thorold, as a resource of cultural heritage value and interest in accordance with Part IV of the *Ontario Heritage Act, 1990, as amended*;
- 2. That staff **BE DIRECTED** to proceed with the designation process of Lock 25, located at the Battle of Beaverdams Park, in the City of Thorold under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act; and

3. That City Clerk **BE DIRECTED** to provide notice of intention in accordance with section 29 (3) of the *Ontario Heritage Act, 1990*.
