Notice of this motion is provided in accordance with the notice and submission deadline requirements of section 11.1 of the City of Thorold's Procedural By-law. Councillor O'Hare seeks to bring forward a motion respecting the Notice of Intent to Designate 18 River Street (the Duncan McFarland House) under Part IV of the *Ontario Heritage Act*.

WHEREAS Sarah King Head CAHP, has conducted research (appended to this motion) relating to the potential to designate the property and structure at 18 River Street, Port Robinson (Duncan McFarland House), located in the City of Thorold, under the *Ontario Heritage Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. O.18;

WHEREAS the property is determined to have historical, geographical, and architectural value as it relates to the early domestic Italianate and Gothic Revival style;

WHEREAS the Heritage Advisory Committee recommended this heritage designation; and

WHEREAS designation of this property will support the City of Thorold's cultural heritage goal and objective to identify, conserve, and enhance its significant cultural heritage resources.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Corporation of the City of Thorold enacts as follows:

- 1. That City Thorold Council **CONSIDER** 18 River Street, Port Robinson, located in the City of Thorold, as a resource of cultural heritage value and interest in accordance with Part IV of the *Ontario Heritage Act*, as amended;
- 2. That City staff **BE DIRECTED** to proceed with the required process to designate 18 River Street under Part IV of the *Ontario Heritage Act*; and
- 3. That City Clerk **BE DIRECTED** to provide notice of intention to designate the property in accordance with Section 29 (3) of the *Ontario Heritage Act*.
