Schedule A – Permit Terms & Conditions

All permit holders under this Agreement and Site Alteration By-law must:

- 1. Notify the city within 48 hours before starting any land-disturbing activity.
- 2. Provide the city with a schedule in advance and submit biweekly quality and quantity reports.
- 3. Inform all adjacent owners/residents affected by the work at least 2 weeks before commencement.
- 4. Install all site control measures outlined in the approved ESC plan before beginning soil stripping.
- 5. Maintain road drainage systems, stormwater systems, control measures, and other facilities.
- 6. Repair any sedimentation or erosion damage to adjacent surfaces and watercourses caused by site alteration activities.
- 7. Restoration / re-vegetation of disturbed areas with temporary measures such as mulch or seeding
- 8. Inspect the ESC measures at least once a week and after severe rain events, report to the City, and complete any necessary repairs within 48 hours to the City's satisfaction.
- 9. Keep roads and sidewalks used for site access in good, mud- and dust-free condition during construction.
- 10. Implement additional control measures not identified in the ESC Plan if deemed necessary by the City to prevent erosion and sediment damage to neighboring properties.
- 11. Keep a copy of the Alteration permit on-site.
- 12. Be responsible for the actions of agents, employees, contractors, and subcontractors who may cause non-compliance with the permit.
- 13. Allow City employees and anyone accompanying them to enter the site for compliance inspections or to perform necessary work to ensure compliance with the permit.
- 14. Conduct site alteration activities only between 7 am to 5 pm, Monday through Friday, and not on Sundays or statutory holidays unless a construction noise exemption has been issued.
