6.1 <u>CAO 2-2023</u>

Application to the Rural Economic Development Program

- That the addition to the capital budget of the deferred \$88,000 for improvements to the Lock 7 Viewing Centre, **BE APPROVED** in principle, subject to the successful receipt of the grant;
- 2. That should the grant application be successful, that the required City portion of \$61,600 **BE FUNDED** from the Municipal Land and Building Reserve; and
- 3. That staff **BE AUTHORIZED** to apply to the Rural Economic Development Program.

- 3. That staff **REPORT** to Council on the status of the success of the respective applications with recommendations on the appropriate next steps.

- 2. That the attached 2023 Departmental Capital Budgets **BE APPROVED;**
- 3. That the 10-year forecasts **BE RECEIVED** for information;
- 4. That the Reserve and Reserve Fund schedules **BE APPROVED**;
- 5. That any general surplus/deficit resulting in 2023 **BE ALLOCATED** in equal shares to the Municipal Land and Building Reserve, the Municipal Development Reserve, the Capital Asset Reserve, and the Capital Asset Transportation Reserve funds;
- That 75% of any surplus, to a maximum of \$50,000.00 in the 2023 Winter Control Operating Budget, **BE ALLOCATED** to the Winter Control Stabilization Reserve, provided that this allocation does not create or magnify a deficit at year-end for 2023;
- 7. That Report DF 2-2023 **BE APPROVED** and **ADOPTED** to meet the requirements of Ontario Regulation 284/09, with respect to expenses that have been excluded from the 2023 budget, assuming no further changes to Capital provisions;
- 8. That all other aspects of Report DF 2-2023 **BE APPROVED**; and
- 9. That the Director of Finance **BE AUTHORIZED** to finalize the 2023 City Budget Estimates, with the appropriate Rating By-law presented to Council.
