3.1 Invoice for clean-up – 40 River Road, Thorold

## 3.a. Applicant Presentation

Wayne Michael, Resident, presented at the Public Forum Meeting about the following:

- His health concerns in the period of time before the clean up of his yard
- What he felt were inconsistencies between the Work Order and the invoice for services rendered in the clean up of his property
- The invoice for services rendered in the clean up was overly expensive, and should be lowered
- The invoice should not be enforced as a lien against his property

## 3.b. Staff Response

Jason Simpson, Director, Development Services, spoke about the following:

- The history of non-compliance of the property
- In accordance with enforcement procedures, a Work Order was provided to the property owner. Compliance was not obtained, and in November 2022, the City retained a company to perform a significant clean up of the property

The Resident asked if the invoice can be paid without being registered as a lien on the property. J. Simpson, Director, Development Services, said he can confirm with Finance staff.

He also requested that staff prepare a report regarding the November 2022 clean up work. Mayor Ugulini advised this can be added as an Agenda Item for City Council Meeting.
