3. Public Forum Applicant Presentation

All-way stop - Canby St. and Hamilton Blvd.

3.a. Applicant Presentation

Wonchul Jung, Resident, 91 Canby Street, Thorold, appeared before the Public Forum Committee. He expressed concerns about the all-way stop to be installed at Canby Street and Hamilton Boulevard. He expressed concerns regarding communication respecting the installation and how it will adversely affect his property as one of the stop signs will be installed at the end of his driveway. He provided information respecting alternatives to speed reduction.

3.b. Staff Response

G. Holman, Director, Public Works & Community Services, appeared before the Public Forum Committee. He provided background information regarding traffic issues in the area, a timeline of the process, and staff rationale for recommending the all-way stop.
