Cost Challenges

- 1) We increased the instructor/student ratio based on a trend in schools that students have not matured at the same rate as students pre-pandemic.
- 2) Staffing onsite was prepared for 340 G4 & G5 students based on original reports from principals. 89 students did not participate due to various factors, including limited access to bikes among students, scheduling challenges, and failure to provide consent.
- 3) Student participation signed consent/class list ratio was down from previous years. This was not evident until we were onsite at each rodeo.
- 4) Access to students with bikes at school was down.

Future Opportunities

• Heart Niagara will highlight the success of bike rodeos held in Thorold Elementary schools at our Vulnerable Road User Safety Summit in February. This initiative would not have been possible without the support of the City of Thorold, the Thorold Active Transportation Advisory Committee (TATAC), and Niagara Student Transportation Services (NSTS).
