1. <u>Call to Order</u>

Mayor Ugulini called the meeting to order at 5:34 p.m.

2. <u>Declarations of Interest</u>

There were no declarations of interest.

3. <u>Public Forum Applicant Presentation</u>

3.1 Applicant Presentation

Jeff Loucks, Resident, appeared before the Public Forum Committee. He expressed concerns regarding the City's policy respecting water invoice notices to tenants. He presented regarding the following:

- The changing demographics of Thorold, with more tenants living in the City
- His personal challenges in receiving water bills in Thorold
- His belief that tenants should have the same level of service as owners such as auto pay, tenant name on the bill, and access to bills online

- His preference to return to the City's 2019 policy that allowed for tenants names on bills
- His belief that services fees from email bills should be removed

3.2 <u>Staff Response</u>

Setu Shah, Manager, Finance/Deputy Treasurer, provided the following information:

- The City's policy from 2019 changed due to privacy concerns
- The owner of the property is the main contact and ultimately responsible for the account and the tenant receives a courtesy bill in the mail that does not have the tenant's name on it
- An explanation of late fees
- Seven municipalities in Niagara operate the same as Thorold and three do not provide a bill to tenants

4. Questions from Public Forum Committee

The Public Forum Committee enquired if staff can review potential changes to the City's billing system and tenant notice policy. Setu Shah, Manager, Finance/Deputy Treasurer, advised that staff can look into this matter.
