Notice of this motion is provided in accordance with the notice and submission deadline requirements of section 11.1 of the City of Thorold's Procedural By-law. Councillor O'Hare seeks to bring forward a motion respecting the feeding of wildlife.

WHEREAS, as human development continues to encroach upon natural wildlife habitats, the likelihood increases that animals will venture into residential areas in search of food and shelter;

WHEREAS, the act of feeding wildlife in residential areas encourages animals to become more habituated to human presence, potentially leading to increased risks of aggression and dangerous interactions with people;

WHEREAS, the feeding of wildlife can contribute to the growth of rodent populations, creating further health and safety concerns within communities;

WHEREAS, providing food to wildlife often results in improper diets, leading to malnutrition, illness, and the spread of diseases among animals that may subsequently affect local ecosystems;

AND WHEREAS, wildlife that frequent residential areas in search of food can cause significant damage to homes, gardens, and property, creating costly repairs and safety hazards for residents;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Corporation of the City of Thorold enacts as follows:

1. That Staff **BE DIRECTED** report back to Council respecting options to prohibit the feeding of wildlife within the City of Thorold, through the passage of a by-law, or amendment to a pre-existing by-law.
