



**Title:** Award – Concrete Entrance Replacement - Arena

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### **RECOMMENDATION(S):**

1. That Council approve the tender award for the Concrete Entrance Replacement to Stolk Construction Ltd in the amount of \$11,430.60 (excluding HST), and,
2. That the Mayor and City Clerk be authorized to execute the necessary contract documents.

### **REPORT:**

As approved during the 2021 capital budget process, staff reviewed submissions for the Concrete Replacement at the Arena Front St Entrance and recommend award to Stolk Construction Ltd in the amount of \$11,430.60 (plus HST)

The existing concrete slab has deteriorated over the years from general wear and tear and salt applications.

The scope of work for this tender includes replacement of the concrete entrance from the sidewalk to the doorway threshold, concrete curbing, and catch basin. The rails are 2 years old and will be reinstated as part of the overall scope of work. The work performed will be in compliance with the Ontario Building Code requirements.

A Public Tender for the supply and installation of the equipment was posted on the City's website on February 16th, 2021 to March 25th in accordance with the City's procurement policy.
